Due to intermittent sales in the series, all copies of the Fort Union report (Historic Clay Tobacco Pipe Studies Research Monograph 2) and Pfeiffer's RM-1 are being printed by professional on-demand printing as orders are received. Several copies are kept in stock, but orders for the two RM-2 versions (black and white paperback, or color hardcover) may take 2-3 weeks to fill (RM-1 and the HCTPS #1-3 volumes listed are currently in stock). The cost of the Fort Union volume is higher than previous series volumes due to the extensive photographic plates included, and (if the color/HC version is selected) the use of color photographs and hardcover binding.

In print run of HCTPS Volume 1, the printer slipped the dedication page to the back of the book, making all of the pages shift forward one page. All pages are present and clear, but page 1 one is on the left side, page 2 is on the right, etc. Thus, these misprinted copies of HCTPS 1 are available at a discounted rate. The print quality is excellent, the volume is complete, and the data is very useful; the pages are simply shifted one page (odd # pages on left-hand side).
